

TTIP: Why we care

Multilateral trade liberalization efforts stalled in Geneva More than €37bn of EU mechanical engineering goods exported to the US (2012)

- Massive growth and jobs potential
- Highly regulated regions
- €2bn traded every day
- Will impact 3rd countries

Include Machinery in the TTIP negotiations

- Complete elimination of remaining tariffs
- Address and prevent regulatory divergences & technical barriers build the system
 - Environment requirements for construction equipment
 - Harmonization of standards for construction equipment
 - Public procurement liberalization
 - 3rd country market access for remanufacturing
